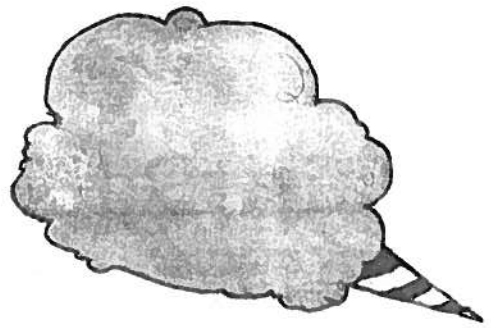


Rain, Rain, Go Away
